

# Manager instructions EM3054 Hotel mode

## Hotel mode

JJ = Double signal, J = Long signal, ☆ = Light (LED) flashes, ★ = Light (LED) stays on,
① = Number on entry, ♡ = Press and hold till JJ ★.

## **General**

The lock operates with a numeric six-digit manager code (factory mode: 1 2 3 4 5 6) or a 4 digit user code. The lock has 2 different modes:

- 1. The open mode. Entering 4 digits will program the next opening code.
- 2. The secured mode. The lock has been closed with a 4-digit code and requires this code to open.

Each key press is confirmed with an audible and light signal. After entry of a valid code a double signal follows. An invalid entry is followed by a long signal. After 10 seconds without entry, an already started code entry is cancelled.

#### **Open with managercode**

**Press and hold** key "1" until double signal. The light remains on during the following actions. Enter manager code *S* The lock will open.

## Change manager code (with door open)

**Press and hold** key "0" until double signal. The light remains on during the following actions.

- Enter old code 🎜
- Enter new code JJ and repeat new code JJ

In case of entry errors (long signal  $\mathcal{P}$ ), the old code remains valid.

## Keypad check

**Press and hold** key "5" until double signal and light stays on. The light remains on during the following actions. Enter successively 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,0 If key = OK  $\Im$  (double signal) If key = not OK  $\checkmark$  (long signal) For example:
